



The National Society and the Liturgical Commission wish to appoint a suitably qualified Project Officer to deliver aspects of their joint *Resourcing School Worship* initiative, with effect from September 2010.

The person will be appointed on a consultancy basis in line with the terms set out in the job specification at www.transformingworship.org.uk Tasks will include overseeing the production of musical and liturgical resources including typesetting scores, editing text and music, producing backing tracks, demonstration and echo tracks for songs, liaising with web designers and builders, and maintaining the website once designed and built.

In the first instance, the consultancy is offered for 45 days over 6 months but it is anticipated that the post will continue for up to 2 years.
